- The fees specified in Section A above will not be refunded in all cases, including but not limited to: enrolled but not attending the school, absence, suspension from the school etc.

3. SIBLINGS POLICY

- 3.1. This policy is applied to the tuition fee only and for families with 2 or more biological children who enroll at the Canadian International School System provided that tuition is paid in full and on time.
- 2nd child: 5% discount is applied to debit tuition.
 - 3rd and subsequent children: a 10% discount is applied to debit tuition.
- 3.2. This policy does not apply to a family whose child(ren) has already received financial-aid or any other CISS special offers.

4. RE-ENROLMENT POLICY AND PARENTS' RESPONSIBILITY

- 4.1. For all returning students, a placement for the student in the new school year is guaranteed until **June 30, 2021** provided the following requirements are met:
- Re-enrolment confirmation is received by the school according to the annual re-enrolment procedure.
 - **Re-enrolment deposit** or **Full year tuition fee for 2021-2022** is recorded by the CIS Accounting Department.
- 4.2. After **June 30, 2021**, the school prioritizes class arrangements for all students on the condition that:
- Students are accepted according to the school's Policy of Enrolment and Re-enrolment.
 - Placements are available at the appropriate grade level.
 - Tuition fees are paid in full and on time as per the school policy.
- 4.3. Tuition and other fees are only applicable once the student is accepted by the school. Complete payment of tuition and other fees **prior to** the student's official acceptance does not offer any guarantee of placement for the student, or any promotions, special rates.
- 4.4. In a case where the tuition fee is paid in advance but the student is not eligible to meet with the school's enrolment conditions, the school commits to refund the tuition without incurring interest.

5. TIME OF PAYMENT AND PAYMENT METHODS

- 5.1. All tuition and other fees are considered valid payments and eligible for preferential policies (including payment discount) and are applied based on the date the school receives the full amount via bank transfer or by cash or other forms without any deduction for any transaction fees (e.g. bank transfer fees).
- 5.2. Payment in cash, via bank transfer or by bank card at the school.

6.2. Percentage of other fees

Meal service, Bus service and Boarding house fees are calculated at the rate of service usage until the end of the school year.

7. REFUND POLICIES

7.1. Withdrawal Procedure

- Parents must complete and submit **<<Withdrawal form>>** to the Academic Services Office (ASO) at least 60 days prior to the student's last day.
- Any cases of absence without advanced notice or verbal notification or otherwise improper notice will be considered invalid and will not be accepted.

7.2. Percentage of refund

Refund policies are **only** applied to **Tuition paid in full** and are subject to the following schedule:

NOTE:

- The refunded fees and other fees will be interest-free and non-refundable for the days the student is absent during the school year.
- The refund policy is applicable to all withdrawal cases (for force majeure, pandemic, natural disasters or any other reasons) and all suspension cases regarding any breach of discipline or school violations or any other reasons (diseases which lead to any disability to continue their study...).
- The deduction of the re-enrollment deposit fee under the circumstance of withdrawal before the school start day, will be applied to all cases inclusive of paid, unpaid or have not paid of re-enrolment deposit fee.
- In the case of force majeure such as fire, weather, natural disaster, epidemic, pandemic, war, terrorism, social instability / violence or any event beyond the control of the school that forces the school to be temporarily closed, the school reserves the right to actively substitute and / or adjust the curriculum and learning methods according to the situation at that time while maintaining commitments to completion of the school year program for students. Simultaneously, the school is under no obligation to reimburse any fees paid to the school previously (except for meals and transportation service, if applicable). Parents are responsible to settle the full school year payment to ensure the student completes the school year program.

7.3. Time of refund

- Refund amounts are to be made within **15-20 working days** after the approved student's last day.
- In the event that the parent does not submit the withdrawal form 60 days in advance, the school will make a refund transaction to the parents after 30 working days, counting from the student's last day at the school, submitted on the withdrawal form.

7.4. Refund cases

Fees are non-refundable **except** under the following circumstances:

- a) **Meal, bus services:** Refunds are made in accordance with the policy of each service.
- b) **Boarding house:**
 - The percentage of refund is proportional to the remaining time of the service which has not been used by the student. The time is calculated on a monthly basis, based on the number of months of using the service;
 - Parents must inform the Academic Services Office (ASO) at least 30 days prior to the student's last day of using the service.



8. LATE PAYMENT POLICY

- Late payments: After 15 days from the last required payment date, a 0.1% penalty is applied on the total amount of the outstanding fee on a daily basis. The penalty will depend on the actual receiving date at CIS. Besides, the school reserves all rights to allow the student(s) to continue at school or not regarding late payments.
- In the case of non-payment: After 30 days from the due date of payment, in addition to the 0.1% penalty per day, the school has the right to refuse to accept students to continue studying at the school.
